









Improvement of Quality of Gynecologic Cancer Care in West Georgia

Effective fight against malignant disease (including gynecologic) remains a public health challenge of the 21st century for global world as well for Georgia and especially in regions where the population has low geographical accessibility to modern methods of prevention, early detection and treatment of the cancer disease.

To address the above-mentioned problem, Caritas Czech Republic starts a new project in support to Georgian Medical Holding to improve the quality of oncogynecological services in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti and Ajara regions. The project encompasses support of improvement of technical capacities of the state-owned large hospitals in region as well as increase skills for medical professionals.

PROJECT AIM

To improve the geographic accessibility to gynecologic services in West Georgia.

PROJECT RESULTS

- Gynecological departments in Rukhi and Batumi state hospitals will be equipped with latest models of endoscopy medical devices and surgical tools.
- At least of 25 medical professionals from state hospitals and 200 rural doctors of Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region will be trained in field of oncogynecology.
- Awareness about prevention of cancer disease among population of region will be improved.

TARGET GROUPS

- Medical staff of state hospitals in Rukhi and Batumi
- Rural doctors in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region
- Population of Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region

PROJECT FOCUS

- **Equip hospitals** with latest models of endoscopy medical devices and surgical tools to improve geographical accessibility to modern minimum invasive methods of treatment (bloodless surgery) for population of regions.
- **Build the capacity** of medical professionals in the oncogynecology diagnosis, treatment and prevention of cancer diseases.
- Increase involvement of primary healthcare workers in early detection and management of cancer disease.
- Raise awareness about cancer disease and its prevention among population of regions.
