



Cattle Farming in Georgia: Towards Increased Productivity, Competitiveness and Sustainability

Together for Profitable Cattle Farming!

The project aims at increasing income of the farmers living in three project areas (Tusheti, Pshav-Khevsureti and Khulo Municipality) by changing their practices related to livestock breeding and feeding, animal health, and pasture management towards more sustainable and productive ones, and by improving their access to the market through business development, increasing sanitary and phyto-sanitary standards, and through linkages to buyers and finances. Moreover, the project will also identify recipients for potential transfer of Czech know-how in precision agriculture.



PROJECT RESULTS



at least **75 farmers** will be trained in modern beef production practices.



at least **50 supported farms** will follow sustainable and more productive cattle farming practices.



at least **75 farmers** will be supported in improving their access to the market and securing stable market position.




at least **6 local insemination specialists** will be trained (3 in Khulo, 2 in Akhmeta/Tusheti and 1 in Pshav-Khevsureti) and at least **50 artificial inseminations** will be conducted.

In parallel the project, through competitive matching grant scheme, will support procurement of machinery, equipment and other inputs needed for livestock production development.

TARGET GROUPS

The project will target 75 farmers from Tusheti, Pshav-Khevsureti and Khulo Municipality. Also, veterinarians, extension workers, Artificial Insmemination specialists, buyers and middlepersons and Czech companies active in precision agriculture. Final project recipients will be families of the small-hold farmers (at least 200 persons) and broader communities of Tusheti, Pshav-Khevsureti and Khulo Municipality.
